### **Woodcrest Christian names Lopez new boys basketball head coach:**

Woodcrest Christian athletic director Charlie Ricards has announced Josh Lopez as the school's new varsity boys basketball head coach. He replaces Eric Strano who spent three years as Royals head coach with a cumulative record of 51-35 (two games as acting head coach-one each under Barkley & Mossman) & 22-20 in Ambassador League play. Strano's teams made two postseasons in three years as Royals head coach reaching the Division 4AA semifinals in 2016-2017. In total he spent 17 years on the Woodcrest Christian coaching staff serving as an assistant under Bob Barkley (2005-2012) and Scott Mossman (2012-2016) prior to his head coaching stint. Lopez comes from Riverside Poly where he served as the Bears freshman coach under Yancy Dodson.

### **Jorgenson resigns as Lady Knights girls basketball coach:**

Ontario Christian girls basketball coach Danielle Jorgenson announced her resignation on May 10th after three years to spend more time with family including watching daughter Annaka play volleyball at Azusa Pacific University. Jorgenson posted an overall mark of 47-33 and was 23-19 in Ambassador League contests. Two of her three Lady Knights teams made it to the CIF-SS playoffs reaching a quarterfinal in 2018. However the Broncos on May 15th announced George Jones as their new head coach. Matlock will serve as an assistant on next year's staff.
